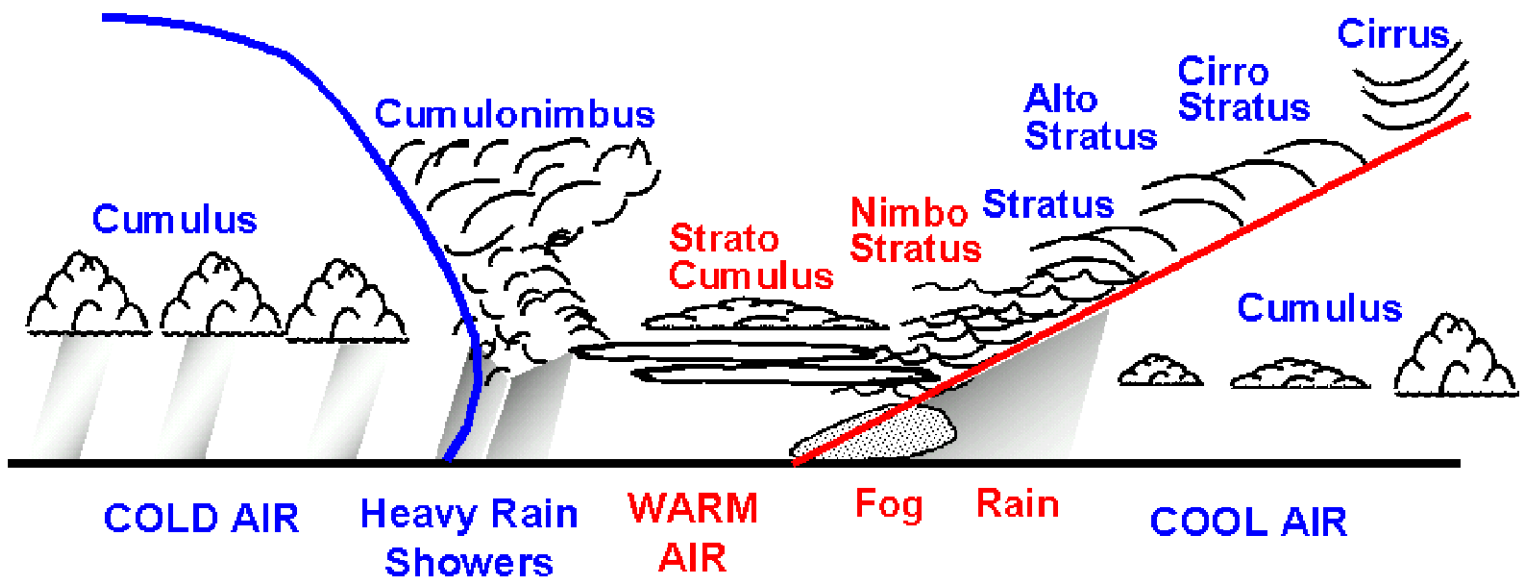


Cloud Formation



As a depression or low pressure passes over you will experience the cloud formations and rain as the system moves from left to right. First you will experience the this wispy cirrus cloud which will build up with the Cirro stratus (stratus being layered). The cloud will build up as the Nimbo Stratus moves in. At about 200nm from the warm front it will start to rain lightly, this will build up to persistent rain. When the front passes the rain will stop and you will feel a change in temperature. At the end of the 'warm sector' the 'cold front' will be marked by heavy rain and a drop in temperature.
